To mark International Women's Day, African Women on Board with support from E-Health Africa, Avon HMO, Capital Club, BellaNaija, and The Macallan, convened stakeholders from Nigeria's health sector and beyond to discuss action steps from our report, 'A Balanced Prescription: Leadership & Innovation in Nigeria's Health Sector'.

From talk to action: key takeaways

A central theme emerging from the discussion was the urgent need for systemic change to facilitate women's leadership in healthcare. This begins with integrated mentorship programs within academic institutions, recognizing that early exposure and support are critical for building a pipeline of future female leaders. Crucially, true empowerment is intrinsically linked to financial independence, providing women with the resources and autonomy to make their own choices and navigate challenges. To achieve this, robust data collection and analysis across all levels of organizations, institutions and the larger society are essential to inform decisions and track progress toward gender equity.

Beyond foundational changes, the conversation highlighted actionable strategies for immediate impact. This includes a deliberate effort to reshape the narrative surrounding women's health and leadership through intentional media engagement, actively breaking down stereotypes and promoting positive representation. Furthermore, dismantling the "culture of shame" around women's health issues, including often-overlooked conditions, is paramount. Finally, a powerful challenge was issued to perceive women-led healthcare businesses not solely as social endeavours, but as competitive, globally recognized entities, driving innovation and economic growth.
