We are pleased to announce that the 1st annual [Climate Change Photo Essay Prize](#) is open for entries until **30th April 2023**. The prize is open to young people aged **18 to 30** from Africa and the diaspora community. Entrants do not need to be professional photographers or artists — all are encouraged to enter.

Climate change is one of the most important issues of our time, and we are thrilled to launch the prize with the theme: *Climate change and your community*.

Entrants are asked to submit a photo essay of three to five photographs that tell a cohesive story and address the theme. Entrants may add captions to annotate/illustrate their photographs. However, they should be aware that the story told through the images themselves, as opposed to any accompanying text, will be the main thing that submissions are judged on.

Winning entries will be announced at the **Africa Soft Power Summit in Kigali, Rwanda in May 2023**. Full prizes, which include a curated exhibition of the winners' work, will be announced soon.
